How to become an Examiner Mentor

Examiner Mentors are senior Lifesaving Society Examiners appointed by the Society to mentor examiner candidates through their apprenticeship phase and approve them for examiner certification.

When working with an apprenticing examiner candidate, the Examiner Mentor is responsible for the smooth conduct of the examination, and only the Examiner Mentor (as the examiner of record) has the authority to make pass/fail decisions and sign test sheets.

This dual responsibility – evaluation of the award candidates while supervising and evaluating an apprentice examiner – is a challenging but rewarding experience.

Prerequisites: Examined a minimum of three exams in a specific stream.

Process:

- Application <u>Complete the application form</u> and return it to the Lifesaving Society office.
- 2. **Learning Opportunity** If approved, the Society will be in touch to arrange the learning opportunity.
- 3. **Assessment** After completing the learning opportunity the Society's Training Programs Director will complete an assessment to determine if they are going to appoint you as an Examiner Mentor.

Required references: Examiner Handbook.

Costs: There is no fee for appointment as an Examiner Mentor.

Candidate recognition: Examiner Mentor appointment will appear on your Find a Member record.


Join us at our AGM
